We will meet at the Buckeye Library (6625 Wolff Rd, Medina, OH 44256) on the **1st and 3rd Wednesdays** of each month from **6:30 to 8:00 PM**, cycling through six discussion topics designed to bring help, support, encouragement, and information to those walking the road of cancer: *Battling Fear and Depression, Feeling All Alone, Facing Death, All About Treatment, Frustration and Praise for the Medical World, and The Need for Support*. Each meeting will focus on open discussion and shared experiences, creating a safe space for anyone affected by cancer to find comfort and hope.

John is a three-year survivor of pancreatic cancer and knows firsthand the challenges and emotions that come with a cancer diagnosis and treatment. Inspired by the support he received from family, his church community, friends, and even strangers who gave him the courage to keep going, he is starting a faith-based cancer support group for the local community.
